Deluxe private club near Dornoch



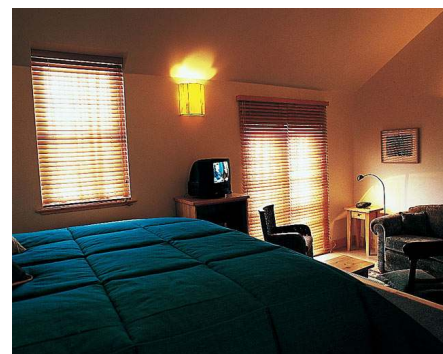
